WILD RENFREW SEASIDE COTTAGES

You'll find Wild Renfrew Seaside Cottages nestled at the end of West Coast Road, where forest, river and sea meet. So kick back and relax in a plush and private, waterfront log cottage or cosy lodge room. Immerse yourself in nature with forested hikes, long stretches of beautiful, sandy beaches and the quaint Pacific Northwest town of Port Renfrew.
